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mongodb installation woes

Installation on aws 2023 /aws 2

So the general advice on the net is to do:

```
dnf install mongodb-org
```

When you get to mongosh ... you lose...

You'll get an error like:

And its all very sad!

So... to fix this:

```
dnf remove mongodb-org
```

```
dnf install mongodb-mongosh-shared-openssl3
```

```
dnf install mongodb-org
```

</code>

Somehow installing mongodb-org straight gets the wrong version of mongosh installed.

No one likes dependencies.

Now at least mongosh works. Wish I knew where to send this bit so it gets fixed!
